FEES AND COSTS

The following fees and costs are typical in a routine K-1 fiancée visa case from original USCIS filing to K-1 visa interview. It does not include fees, or government costs for Adjustment of Status following marriage in the U.S. Fees and costs are payable by bank transfer, international wire transfer or cash.

INITIAL FEES and COSTS:

Attorney's fees	60,000 ฿ + 7% VAT (total 64,200)
USCIS filing fee	\$340 USD
Courier fees	4,000 ฿

FEES PAYABLE TO 3RD PARTIES PRIOR TO INTERVIEW:

Medical exam fees	Average 5,000 ฿ but, may be slightly higher if additional tests, vaccinations or treatment is required.
Non-immigrant visa fee	\$350 USD to US Embassy payable at Thai Post Office

Other: Minor miscellaneous expenses for such things as passport photographs

Please note that the foregoing fees apply to "routine" K-1 cases in which no legal grounds of inadmissibility apply (ie, prior criminal convictions, prior US visa violations, prostitution, communicable diseases, etc.). If you believe that some legal grounds of inadmissibility may apply to your fiancée, please tell us your concerns and, if we believe that it is, in fact, a problem, we will advise you as to the legal effect and, if any additional application(s) are necessary as a result of a legal grounds of inadmissibility, what the cost of any such remedial applications would be.
